Bible Time One story will be taught each week. A story binder will come home on Tuesday. The stories are to be read to the student, signed by the parent, and returned to school the next day.

Reading K5 will learn letter recognition, letter formation, basic reading skills, and real reading. The K4 students will be exposed to all of the alphabet letters and sounds as well as proper letter formation. A variety of books will be read throughout the year.

Math K5 will study the meaning of numbers, counting, basic geometry, measurement skills, addition, and subtraction. K4 will do hands-on exploration of basic math concepts.

Units Various age-appropriate social studies and science topics will be discussed throughout the year.

Center Time During this time the children will be divided into groups and participate in teacher-selected and self-chosen activities.

Music Music is integrated into all areas of the curriculum as well as being a stand-alone class. K5 will also attend joint K5-2nd grade Cherub Choir sessions twice a week.

Phy Ed The students will participate in daily movement activities as well as a Phy Ed class.

Show & Tell Show & Tell is held each Friday. A schedule will be sent home.

Library Students will be able to check out library books from our classroom library every day. Books are due back in one week.
