Staying Safe Top Practices

1. Don't send a sick child to school.
2. Send your child to school wearing a mask. We will have some if you need them.
3. We will have entrances, bathrooms and hallways marked for social distancing and will instruct your child how to best social distance at school.
4. When your child arrives at school, his/her temperature will be taken. If his/her temperature is above **100.3 degrees**, he/she will be refused entrance to school.
5. Upon entering school, children should empty their backpacks and remove their masks to eat breakfast. Following breakfast, students in grades K4-2nd will put on their clear face shield (provided by the school).
6. Hand sanitizers and wipes for work spaces will be available in each classroom. Desks will be distanced 6 feet apart.
7. While at their desks, students in grades 3-8 will not wear masks. Parents may request a face shield for their child if they wish.
8. Students moving through the classroom, hallway and bathrooms will wear a mask or face shield.
9. Recess, bathroom breaks and lunches have been staggered to limit classes using these shared spaces at the same time. Hand sanitizer will be placed at drinking fountains. Students are to clean hands prior to touching the fountain. Some classes will be asked to bring water bottles.
10. While heading outside, students should wear their masks, but masks should not be worn during physical activity. Social distancing outside is important and students "hanging out" and talking should be masked.
11. Social distancing will take place at pickup. We discourage parents from making use of aftercare as we wish to keep students from different classrooms from having contact with one another. Aftercare guidelines will come later.
