Winter Weather Guidelines & Important Notes

We will go outside every day that the temperature/wind chill is above 0 (F)

Students should have their winter jackets, hats, gloves, snow pants, and boots every day.

It is preferable that your child have nylon mittens with stuffing inside instead of knit ones. Nylon mittens will keep their hands warmer and dryer.

No boots, snow pants, and gloves= No playing in the snow. Students will stand by the wall away for the snow and wetness.

Younger students should bring a canvas shopping bag or department store like bag for storing and carrying winter gear (grocery store bags break very easily and are too small).

- Students MUST have tennis shoes (or other shoes) to wear at school. Boots may not be worn in the classroom. The wetness and salt is not good for and ruins our floors and carpets. It also tracks in water that makes moving around the classroom unsafe.
- Parents are welcome, if you have the ability, to bring in a good fitting pair of school shoes that can stay at school all winter. Then you do not have to worry about forgetting them and having to get that dreaded- "We need you to bring shoes call".
