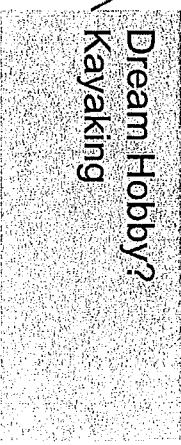

1 John 4:19 We love because he first loved us.

This passage serves as the big **WHY**. I explain that this is the motivation for everything we do. I will explain to students the little why whenever possible. The little **why** has to do with order and efficiency.

Example: Walking Strong at a zero with hands behind our backs in the hallway.

Big WHY: Students show love (respect & obedience) to the Principal who has said that students should walk strong in the hallways.

Little why: Other classrooms will be distracted if students talk in the classroom. The transition needs to be fast so learning time is not shortened.

Management Goals:

- Facilitate a safe learning environment.
- Provide Multiple opportunities per hour for structured movement.
- Provide multiple opportunities per day for some type of individualized feedback.
- Discover and meet the specific needs of each of my students.
- Achieve and maintain student engagement in each of the content areas.

For all of these, there are no prescribed consequences (aside from those outlined in the handbook). Using Love and Logic, consequences will be consistent but designed to fit the choice that a student made.

Homework Policy

Last Revision: 7-27-2021

- When a child has late/missing homework, recess recovery will be used.
- If a child has 3 or more late/missing homework in a week, a text message will be made to notify a caregiver.
- Caregivers are given Powerschool login information to monitor their child's progress.
- If a caregiver is notified more than two weeks in a quarter, the teacher will schedule a meeting to come up with goals
 - Two teacher goals
 - Two student goals
 - One parent goal

Word of Life Uniform Policy

1. Navy blue, black or khaki slacks or shorts for boys.
2. Navy blue, black or khaki slacks, jumpers, skirts, shorts, capris or skirts for girls.
3. Any items in #1 or #2 with loops must use a black belt.
4. Any solid colored long or short sleeved polo shirts. Shirts must be tucked in with collars down. Buttoned and collared dress shirts are also allowed. Long sleeved dress shirts are allowed. Logos on shirts must be appropriate and smaller than the size of a fist.
5. Navy blue, black or white button down, zipper, pull-over, or vest sweaters.
6. All uniform clothing must be kept clean and free of rips, tears, and excessive patches, fading and stains.
7. Any color long-sleeved solid color t-shirts or compression shirts may be worn under polo shirts for warmth. No turtlenecks are allowed under any uniform shirt.
8. White or black solid color socks. Socks must match each other in color.
9. Shoes are to be worn at all times (including physical education) and must match. Shoes must match each other in color and style. No flip flops, sandals or open-toed shoes.
10. No jeans / no cargo pants / no sagging. No skinny jeans. No stretch fabric pants. No leggings except under jumpers or skirts. Leggings must be blue, black or white.
11. No jackets, hooded sweatshirts, sweat suit tops, fleece tops, caps, hats, berets, or gloves may be worn in class.

Students are to be dress code ready when they walk in the building.
