

Word of Life Uniform Policy

The attire for the classroom should be modest and God pleasing. The interpretation of the dress code is at the teacher's discretion. Children not meeting the dress code may be asked to change their clothing at school. Students who continually break the dress code may be subject to school discipline policies.

Tops

Any solid-colored long- or short-sleeved polo shirt (Logos on polo must be smaller than a fist).

Any solid-colored long- or short-sleeved button-down dress shirt.

Shirts must be tucked in with collars down.

Any solid-colored long-sleeved t-shirt or compression shirt may be worn under a shirt for warmth.

Pull-over, zipper, button-down, or vest sweaters – black, blue, or white (A sweater is made from knitted yarn.)

No jackets, hoodies of any kind, sweat suit tops, fleece tops, caps, hats, berets, mittens, or gloves.

Bottoms

Pants/shorts for boys – black, blue, or khaki.

Pants/shorts/jumpers/skorts/capris/skirts for girls – black, blue, or khaki.

No jeans, sagging pants, sweat pants, or pajama pants.

No leggings except under skirts or jumpers – blue, black, or white.

Shoes and Socks

Any pair of matching socks Matching shoes to be worn at all times.

No flip flops, sandals, or open-toed shoes.

General

All uniform clothes must be kept clean and free of rips, tears, excessive patches or stains.

Other

Facial make-up may be worn in moderation.

Ear piercing is acceptable. Other body piercings are not permitted.

Hair color must be natural colors and no other colors are permitted.

Headbands should fit closely to the head without large decorations, ie. ears, flowers.
